1-1:05: Janet welcomes everyone, introduces Kaija

1:05-1:15: Kaija provides overview summary of last year's presentation, work done throughout the year on BGP, reason for today's workshop, and introduces each panelist. Kaija reviews schedule for the session.

1:15-2: Panelists each have 7-10 minutes to provide their response to these two questions:

- Please share your work/experience on gun violence and gun violence prevention from a public health perspective.
- How do you get people from different perspectives on the issue of guns to talk about gun violence prevention *together*?

2-2:20: Attendees will split up into 5 groups – one group with each panelist leading a discussion around their specific expertise on one type of gun violence or gun violence prevention. Each group should have a recorder who will report back to the group what was discussed and share one question for the whole panel. Questions to discuss include:

- You just heard a range of perspectives on gun violence and the role of collaboration and technology to bring diverse perspectives together to discuss gun violence prevention. How does this apply/relate to your role in social work?
- How might you use specific ideas discussed in your work?
- Do you see any fitting into your continuing educational needs (credit hours)?
- Please come up with one question from your group to pose to the whole panel.
- Please fill out the sheets on the table with ideas for speakers to add to the BGP speaker's corner, venues for community conversations, additional resources (research/data, media, art, books, music) to add to the BGP website, etc.

2:20-2:40: Each group will report out what they discussed.

2:40-3: Each group asks their question to the panel and they respond.

Other details:

Stacey and Janet will create a power point which will include the panelists' names, schedule for the day, questions to discuss during small groups, and contact information. Panelists' slides will be included in this Power Point. Panelists will have 7-10 minutes to respond to the questions listed above and then facilitate small group discussions, mostly centered on their topic.
